



**SCOUTS CANADA
CHINOOK COUNCIL
Life Time Achievement Award**

The Lifetime Achievement Award has been created to recognize Scouters who have built (establish) an enduring legacy to Scouting through a lifetime of continuous service to others. The award is intended to recognize only those extraordinary Scouters who have deeply influenced and significantly contributed to the vision, direction, and growth of Scouts Canada Chinook Council, they have faithfully demonstrated a lifetime of quality leadership, illustrated and reinforced the significance of the values found in the Scout Promise and Scout Law.

The prestige of the award requires the criteria be general in nature to allow members of the Chinook Council Adult Recognition Committee to exercise wisdom, flexibility, and discretion in the evaluation and selection of a worthy recipient. Although any past or present member may be nominated, a nominee must meet the following criteria: (1) A Member in good standing (2) National Service Award recipient (3) Continued to render outstanding and dedicated service to the Chinook Council on a sectional, group, Council or national level. (4) Typically an adult member of Scouts Canada for a minimum of 40 years.

Nominations must be received in the Chinook Council Office five months prior to the Council Adult Recognition Ceremony. Applications will be submitted to the Chinook Council Recognition Committee for evaluation and recommendation. The successful nominee must be approved by the members of the Chinook Council Adult Recognition Committee to receive the award. The award will be presented only at the Adult Recognition Ceremony. Given the nature and prestige of the award, it is recommended that normally no more than one recipient be recognized each year. The award recipient will be notified prior to the award ceremony. The award may not be presented posthumously.

In keeping with the nature of the award, the recognition is not a uniform item, pin, ribbon, or other device, but will be a significant personalized recognition suitable for display in the recipient's home or office.
